

8th Grade Disneyland Field Trip Information Monday, June 2nd 2025



There will be many fun ways our 8th graders are going to celebrate their final year at Miraleste, and one of them is the 8th Grade School Day at Disneyland on Monday, June 2nd.

We have been working with Disneyland to confirm they have reserved enough tickets for our 8th grade class on Monday, June 2nd, and Disney has shared that to guarantee enough tickets at our group rate, we must purchase the tickets more than 60 days before our trip.

Therefore, we will be collecting payment beginning the week of Monday, March 10th.

The LAST DAY TO PURCHASE: FRIDAY, MARCH 21ST, 2025.

One-Park Disneyland Ticket plus Bus Transportation is \$175.00.

The details for the 8th Grade Day at Disneyland (one park only ticket– Disneyland) are:

- 1. Students will need to be dropped off at MIS TAB by 6:45 a.m. on MONDAY, JUNE 2ND.
- 2. Students should **return back to MIS by 11:00 p.m. that night**. The school will send out communication to 8th grade parents that night when we leave the park to give a more accurate return time.
- 3. Students will have one mandatory check-in during their time at Disneyland. The check-in time will be between 2 p.m and 4 p.m., and students will be told where the check-in location is. Chaperones will also be available at a pre-determined location throughout the day and key contacts by cell phone. The rest of the time they will get to spend with their friends at Disneyland.
- 4. Please provide your child with a money card (ATM, pre-loaded card) for food that day...**Disneyland is a CASHLESS park**. You can also pack them food to be eaten at a designated Disney Picnic Area.
- 5. Students purchasing tickets through MIS Booster Club must ride the school-provided bus transportation. Students may not be driven by parents to or from Disneyland.
- 6. Students are not required to attend this field trip. If a student does not attend, they are expected to attend school on that day or will be marked absent.

If your student is going to Disneyland for MIS 8th Grade Disney Day, you and your student must follow this timeline:

First, parents, please **complete the Permission Slip** for your 8th grade student sent through your **Aeries Communications Parent Portal**. (If you did not receive the email with the attached

permission slip, please make sure you have turned on (clicked) that you will receive all notifications. If it is only clicked on emergency, you will not get the email.) Your student will not be able to purchase a ticket without a completed permission slip.

Next, your student will go to the table in front of the Front Office to purchase their ticket and pay the bus fee. Bring cash or check made out to MIS Booster Club in the amount of \$175 before school or during lunch the week of March 10th or the week of March 17th. Please note, the Front Office cannot collect your payment until the permission slip is completed. If your student tries to pay for their ticket and the permission slip has not yet been completed online, they will be directed to call you and ask you to complete the permission slip before payment can be received.

When your student turns in their payment to the Front Office between March 10th and March 21st, they will get to sign up for which bus they would like to ride. Students may only sign up for their bus request if **both** the permission slip has been completed and the payment has been turned in.

If they have a **Magic Key Pass** that they plan on using on June 2nd and want to attend 8th Grade Disney Day with their class, the student will need to <u>make their own reservation online through Disneyland Reservations and then purchase only the bus transportation through the Front <u>Office.</u> Do not wait to make your personal Disneyland reservation, because we cannot guarantee there will be reservations available. Bring your cash or check payable to "MIS Booster Club" in the amount of \$45 for bus transportation during the week of March 10th or the week of March 17th.</u>
